
STUDENTS' VISIT TO THE LIBRARY


Date: 12th July, 2025

An introductory library session was organized on Saturday, 12th July 2025 for the newly admitted students of B.A./B.Com. 1st Year at Government Degree College, Shivnagar. The students were accompanied by Prof. Vivekanand Sharma, Convenor of the Library Committee, and Mrs. Anita Kumari, Assistant Librarian. A total of 32 students attended the session. During the session, Mr. Ravinder Kumar, Assistant Librarian, delivered a brief lecture on the services and facilities offered by the college library. Students were introduced to the various information resources available, including the process for consultation of online databases, issuance of academic and reference books, and the rules and discipline to be maintained within the library. The students were also informed about national-level academic initiatives such as the National Digital Library of India (NDLI) and One Nation One Subscription (ONOS), both of which operate under the aegis of the Department of Higher Education, Government of India. The college library holds memberships to these National Informatics Hubs to support the academic and research needs of students and scholars.

Prof. Vivekanand Sharma emphasized the importance of constructive use of free time in the library and encouraged students to develop the habit of regular library use, thereby enhancing their reading and sitting capacity. A few students raised queries regarding the use of online resources, newspapers, and magazines, which were addressed by the library staff. At the end of the session, some students were issued books related to their respective subjects. The session proved to be informative and encouraging, aiming to inculcate good reading habits and awareness about academic resources among the first-year students.
